This funding will be used to

- Increase the number of students in Years 3 and 5 meeting the National Minimum Standards in reading to 100%
- Increase the number of students in the two top bands in reading to Year 3 - 70% and Year 5 - 60%
- Improve teacher capability in the explicit teaching of reading and writing through professional development and coaching

Our initiatives include

- Continue a whole school approach to provide a continuum of literacy support with personalised teaching and intervention that meets the needs of all students
- Continue Literacy Blocks which include a focus on guided writing and reading comprehension
- Provide professional development to teachers and teacher aides on the explicit teaching of reading and writing to ensure there is a school wide consistent approach
- Teachers providing accurate reading assessment to be used in planning for improvement of student results
- Focus on identifying talented students and differentiating the programs to ensure continued improvement in results
